

Grand Challenge Lens Presentation

It's time to teach your group about your Grand Challenge lens and its stakeholders.

Presentation Guidelines:

- Each lens group should prepare an 8-10 minute presentation on their lens and it's stakeholders.
- Each lens group will be responsible for teaching the rest of their team about their lens.
- Everyone in the lens group must stand with their group at the front of the room and have a role in the presentation.
- Each group should prepare a visual to support that helps to clarify their presentation.
- Each group should provide a handout to the rest of the team (to help with recall next semester.)
- Business casual attire required.

Tips for Success

1. Have an awesome opening! Use a startling fact or statistic, tell a story or use a powerful visual or quote, in order to capture the attention of your audience.
2. Be deliberate in your organization: Make a choice on how you should move through your topic: move from big ideas to small ideas (or vice-versa), or move through your topic chronologically, perhaps there's a natural grouping already within your topic.
3. Assign specific roles to each person in your group so that everyone shares the work.
4. Create a schedule with specific dates that everyone can follow when preparing materials.
5. Have a strong closing point so that people remember you!
